Permission to fly kites within 4000 meters of an Aerodrome.

1 Application

This instrument applies to the members of the James Cook University Kiteboarding Club

2 Permission

To operate kites within 4000 metres of Townsville Airport

3 Conditions

Kites may only be flown within the area specified in Schedule 2 in accordance with the conditions mentioned in Schedule 1

4 Expiry

This instrument commences 25 October 2010 and ceases to have effect at the earlier of

1. 31 October 2012
2. the James Cook University Kiteboarding club ceases to exist

Schedule 1 Conditions

- a. only kites manufactured solely for the purpose of kite surfing may be used
- b. kites may only be flown during daylight hours in Visual Meteorological Conditions (VMC)-----note VMC are where there is at least 5000 meters of visibility horizontally and at least 1000' vertical distance from cloud
- c. the operator of a kite must ensure that during normal or abnormal operation a kite does not fly more than 30 meters above the surface
- d. kites flown in accordance with this permission may only be flown within the Kite Flying Area at Pallarenda Beach Townsville. The Kite Flying Area is limited to the beach and 500 meters out to sea between beach access 13 to beach access 18 as shown in Schedule 2 of this permission
